## Faculty

Tuition covers the cost of paying the faculty for their professional instruction and the cost of running studios as well as basic facilities and maintenance needs. Occasionally there are additional fees, like clay, that are based on usage.

When you register for classes we will be happy to provide you with a supply list via mail or email. You should bring the list and any materials you have to the first class and the instructor will review everything with you. Don't spend a lot of money before class begins! Ask the staff what you'll need on the first day.
